

## Damage Control Licences & Permits

### Wildlife Regulation, Schedule 4, Part 6 - Non-licence Animals.

Subject to local bylaws, in areas where no special protections exist, non-licence animals can be hunted without a licence throughout the year. Live trapping is also allowed without a licence, as is trapping mice and some ground squirrels. For further information on trapping, please contact a Fish and Wildlife office or refer to the Alberta Guide to Trapping Regulations.

Non-licence animals can also be possessed live without a permit, except for bats, raccoons and skunks. Bats, raccoons and skunks can only be possessed live for the purpose of re-locating them.
